Statement Regarding Conflict Minerals

indie has always been committed to operating in a socially and environmentally responsible manner in all areas of our business. These commitments are embedded in our company vision and in our corporate social responsibility approach.

We understand that corporate social responsibility extends to our entire supply chain and expect our suppliers to conduct their worldwide operations in a manner that does not result in labor or human rights violations. Our company will proactively undertake due diligence and continuous monitoring of our supply chain to avoid direct or indirect procurement of Conflict Minerals.

"Conflict Minerals" refer to Columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives, which are limited to tantalum, tin, and tungsten, that are financing conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or the adjoining countries which share internationally-recognized borders with the DRC (Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, Republic of Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia).

indie does not knowingly use Conflict Minerals and their byproducts originating from mines controlled by armed groups in the DRC or adjoining countries.
